Eligibility

Pursuant to the Nevada Grow Act, for a business to be selected for this Program, they must have obtained the following milestones prior to application submission: (a) Have its principal place of business within the State of Nevada and have had its principal place of business in this State for at least 2 years; (b) Generate at least \$50,000 but not more than \$700,000 in revenue; and (c) Have a business plan.



Background

Assembly Bill 399, presented by Assemblywoman Dina Neal, was approved by the Nevada State Legislature in 2015. As a Senator, she steadfastly championed the bill in subsequent biennial cycles, driven by her strong belief that utilizing strategic and personalized data methods is crucial for enhancing the strength and resilience of small businesses.
